

## **Department of Psychiatry Outstanding Contribution to the Residency Training Program**

This is awarded each year to the resident who has accepted and fulfilled the administrative responsibilities of the Chief Resident position. The Chief Resident is a senior resident who is selected by the Program Director and Residency Program Committee to perform specific administrative responsibilities related to the Department of Psychiatry's academic and service activities. These responsibilities are carried out in addition to those expected as a normal part of his/her own academic program.

The chief resident has multiple responsibilities including assuming a leadership role for the psychiatry residents, making call schedules, assigning holiday and conference leaves, participating on the Psychiatry Council, the Residency Program Committee and acting as a liaison between the residents and the Program Director and the Department of Psychiatry.

This award is presented to the Chief Resident, who has contributed to our residency program and the Department of Psychiatry over the preceding calendar year. This is a highly valued position and the award is a token of our appreciation for their outstanding contribution.

The award consists of a \$500 cheque and an inscription on the Outstanding Contribution to the Residency Training Program Plaque.

The award will be presented at the Annual Department of Psychiatry Research Day.
