

Department of Psychiatry Resident Award for Undergraduate Teaching

This is awarded to the resident in the Psychiatry program at Queen's University who has shown the most valuable contribution to Undergraduate education. This is based on their contribution/involvement in undergraduate education in a number of areas. The award will be given to the resident who has shown initiative in education and demonstrated high quality teaching as reflected in the feedback from the medical students. The resident is a good role model for the medical students and always conducts himself or herself in a professional manner.

The Clerkship Director will select candidates to be considered for the award, based on their documented contribution to undergraduate education. The Undergraduate Education Committee will make the final decision regarding the award recipient.

The award consists of a \$500 cheque and an inscription on the Resident Annual Teaching Award Plaque.

The award will be presented at the Annual Department of Psychiatry Research Day. The successful nominee will be notified prior to the Research Day.
