

Department of Psychiatry Resident Mentorship Award

This award is presented annually to the faculty member in the Department of Psychiatry at Queen's University who exemplifies what it means to be a resident mentor. The Mentorship Award acknowledges a current faculty member who has exemplified excellence in their provision of education, guidance and support to one or more residents in the program. The award recipient has served as an advisor who is willing to share their knowledge and experience. They have served as a source of inspiration, information and encouragement. They have provided feedback and direction while always maintaining an environment of mutual respect, trust and understanding. They strive to assist the resident(s) to achieve their full potential as a learner and as a professional.

This Selection of the award recipient will be made by the resident body, which is chaired by the Chief Resident(s). All residents may nominate a faculty member to be considered for the award. The candidates will be considered based on the previously described criteria.

The award consists of an inscription on the Resident Mentorship Award Plaque.

The award will be presented at the Annual Department of Psychiatry Research Day. The decision will be made by March 15th, 2017.
