

Department of Psychiatry Resident Mentorship Award

This award is presented annually to the faculty member in the Department of Psychiatry at Queen's University who exemplifies what it means to be a resident mentor.

The Mentorship Award acknowledges a current faculty member who has exemplified excellence in their provision of guidance and support to one or more residents in the program. The award recipient is a faculty member willing to share their wisdom and experiences as a clinician, leader, and academic. They have served as a source of inspiration, information, and provided support and encouragement for residents. They have provided a safe environment for discussion, exchange of ideas and direction while always maintaining an environment of mutual respect, trust, and understanding. They strive to assist the resident(s) to achieve their full potential as a learner and as a professional.

This selection of the award recipient will be made by the resident body, which is chaired by the Chief Resident(s) with the input and guidance from the Postgraduate Program Director. All residents may nominate a faculty member to be considered for the award with the exception of those award recipients within the past 5 years. The candidates will be considered based on the previously described criteria. All nominations must be held in confidence.

The award consists of an inscription on the Resident Mentorship Award Plaque.
