Department of Psychiatry Faculty Award for Undergraduate Teaching

This is awarded to a faculty member in the Department of Psychiatry at Queen's University who has shown the most valuable contribution to Undergraduate education. This is based on their contribution/involvement in undergraduate education in a number of areas. The award will be given to the faculty member who has shown ongoing engagement in education and clinical supervision of clerks. This individual demonstrates high quality teaching as reflected in the feedback from the medical students and clerks. This individual serves as a role model for medical students and clerks.

The Clerkship or Pre-clerkship Directors will select candidates to be considered for the award, based on their documented contribution to undergraduate education. The Undergraduate Education Committee will make the final decision regarding the award recipient. The award consists of an inscription on the Faculty Annual Teaching Award Plaque.
